## PROGRAM INFORMATION

### **COMPETITIVE PROGRAM**

**Program Requirement:** Skaters must be competing at an All-Ontario, WOS or Sectional level AND register for a minimum 3 day/week package (that being 2 competitive days and a minimum of 1 StarSkate day or another full time program); must retain a professional coach affiliated with the Club; must be recommended by their Base Coach and approved by the Technical Director. Maximum 15 skaters per session on the competitive sessions.

#### **Prioritization Policy For Competitive Program**

- 1) Completed application must be received before deadline.
- 2) Skater is a Home Club member.
- 3) Skater has skated in a GFSC program in the immediately preceding session.
- 4) Number of sessions registered for in the GFSC's program(s) for current season.
- 5) Skater is a Home Club member supplementing a full competitive program elsewhere and the number of sessions they are registering for with GFSC, upon availability of space.
- 6) Non-club member supplementing a full competitive program elsewhere and the number of sessions they are registering for with GFSC, upon availability of space.

**Cheques are payable to:** Guelph Figure Skating Club (G.F.S.C.)  
No skater will be allowed on the ice or participate in tests until a registration form has been processed and paid.

**Family Discount:** A \$25 discount applies to families with 3 or more children registered concurrently during a session.

**Cancellation:** The G.F.S.C. reserves the right to change or cancel any program for which there is insufficient paid registration.

**Refunds:** Refunds are only provided with a medical note and written notification to the Board of Directors. . A refund on the unused lessons will be given less a \$10 administration fee. The Skate Canada fee will not be refunded. No refund will be given for missed skating sessions or for those sessions canceled due to test nights, inclement weather or building maintenance problems.

**Withdrawals:** Withdrawal from the program for reasons other than medical (note required) does not remove the obligation to honor post-dated cheques.

**Non-Skating Days:** Friday, April 23<sup>rd</sup>, Monday, May 24<sup>th</sup> (Victoria Day)

**NSF Cheques:** NSF cheques will be charged an administrative fee of \$30. Skaters cannot skate until all outstanding fees are paid in full by cash or certified cheque.

**Program Change:** A \$10 administrative fee will be charged for any program change received once an application has been processed. Program Change Requests recommended by a Coach are exempt from this fee.

**Guest Skating:** The Club must be notified in advance and guest skate purchased through a coach or Club Office. The Club reserves the right to limit access to any session.

**G.F.S.C. Professional Coaches:** Coaches with our Club are selected based on their qualifications and the needs of our membership. All of our coaches have a minimum Level 1 certification from Skate Canada. In order to be a coach in good standing with Skate Canada all coaches are required to hold a current First Aid Certificate.
