

IMPORTANT INFORMATION CONTINUED

Withdrawals: Withdrawal from the program for reasons other than medical (note required) does not remove the obligation to honor post-dated cheques.

Orientation: Information sessions will be provided for the parents of Intermediate skaters during the second week of the spring session. Notices will be posted at the arena.

Non-Skating Days: There are no non-skating days

NSF Cheques: NSF cheques will be charged an administrative fee of \$30. Skaters cannot skate until all outstanding fees are paid in full by cash or certified cheque.

Program Change: A \$10 administrative fee will be charged for any program change received once an application has been processed. Program Change Requests recommended by a Coach are exempt from this fee.

Guest Skating: The Club must be notified in advance and guest skate purchased through a coach or Club Office. The Club reserves the right to limit access to any session.

G.F.S.C. Professional Coaches: Coaches with our Club are selected based on their qualifications and the needs of our membership. All of our coaches have a minimum Level 1 certification from Skate Canada. In order to be a coach in good standing with Skate Canada all coaches are required to hold a current First Aid Certificate.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

INTERMEDIATE PROGRAM

Program Requirement: Completed CanSkate Program, working on CanSkate stages 5 or 6, or Fast Track skater. Skaters are encouraged to seek private or semi-private lessons.

The format of the Intermediate Program is group lessons with the emphasis on teaching skills, free skate and dance. Private lessons may be taught on these sessions by a professional coach of your choice (fees extra). Please see the Club's "Coaches Brochure" available on our website and at the arena for a list of our professional coaches.

INTERMEDIATE/STARSKATE PROGRAM

Program Requirement: Meets criteria for Intermediate Program and requires a transitional period to the StarSkate Program; must retain a professional coach affiliated with the Club.

Skater participates in a 1 day/week Intermediate session **and** a 1 day/week StarSkate session. Formal test work on skills, free skate and dance during the StarSkate session is taught by private lessons from a professional coach of your choice (fees extra).

STARSKATE "A" PROGRAM

Program Requirement: Skaters have NOT passed their Preliminary Free skate Test and must retain a professional coach affiliated with the Club. The skater must register for a minimum 2 day/week package.

STARSKATE "B" PROGRAM

Program Requirement: Skaters must have passed their Preliminary Free skate Test and may include Pre-Preliminary All-Ontario and Sectional level skaters; must retain a professional coach affiliated with the Club. The skater must register for a minimum 2 day/week package.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Registration: Registrations will be processed on a first come, first served basis.

Online registration and payment by credit/debit card is now available on our web site. www.guelphskating.ca

Registration forms can also be downloaded from the Club's website and printed to fill out. Completed registration forms together with a cheque may be mailed, or dropped off at our office or drop box upstairs at Exhibition arena. No faxed registrations or registrations without payment will be accepted. If you need assistance someone will be in our office at the following times:

- Saturdays from 9:00 until noon.

No skater will be allowed on the ice or participate in tests until a registration form has been processed and paid.

Family Discount: A \$25 discount applies to families with 3 or more children registered concurrently during a session.

Cancellation: The G.F.S.C. reserves the right to change or cancel any program for which there is insufficient paid registration.

Refunds: Refunds are only provided with a medical note and written notification to the Board of Directors. A refund on the unused lessons will be given less a \$10 administration fee. The Skate Canada fee will not be refunded. No refund will be given for missed skating sessions or for those sessions canceled due to test nights, inclement weather or building maintenance problems.
